CSM Towns has deployed in support of Operation Joint Guardian, Kosovo (KFOR-2B); the Global War on Terror, Operations Enduring Freedom, Freedoms Sentinel and Operation Inherit Resolve for a total of 51 months, 15 rotations split between Afghanistan, Iraq, and Syria. While deployed to Iraq, CSM Towns served as the Battalion Logistics Operations Cell (BLOC) NCOIC and in Afghanistan he served as the J4 Sergeant Major for a Joint Special Operations Task Force responsible for supporting a complex dual mission set to meet ever-changing theater-wide logistics requirements and also as the Joint Logistics Operations Cell (JLOC) Senior Enlisted Advisor. During the deployment to Syria, CSM Towns spearheaded the logistical support for the 75th Ranger Regiment by conducting the initial pre-deployment site survey and serving as senior logistician on the ground for the reception, staging, onward movement and integration (RSOI). He has also completed a four-month Operational Deployment in support of Task Force Puckett on the Korean Peninsula, serving as the Senior Logistics Planner and the Liaison Officer to Special Operations Command- Korea (SOCKOR).
