

## **LTC Perry C. "Chet" Sosebee Jr.**

### **Commander, 421<sup>st</sup> Multifunctional Medical Battalion, Baumholder, Germany**

Lieutenant Colonel Sosebee was born and raised in Athens, GA. After graduating college, he entered the Army in September 2006 and attended Basic Combat Training (BCT) at Fort Jackson, SC. Upon graduation he attended Officer Candidate School at Fort Benning, GA and was commissioned in the Medical Service Corps on 12 April 2007. He is now a 70H, Medical Plans and Operations Officer, and has served in tactical, operational, and strategic units and has two deployments to Afghanistan (Camp Eggers, Kabul and Operational Base Fenty, Jalalabad).

His most recent assignment was as the Force Manager for 68<sup>th</sup> Theater Medical Command. LTC Sosebee assumed command of 421<sup>st</sup> Multifunctional Medical Battalion on 20 June 2024 in Baumholder, Germany.
