

COL Avery J. Carney was born and raised in a Chicago suburb. He entered military service in October 1996 at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri. After completing IET and AIT he served in the Indiana National Guard as a Engineer Heavy Equipment Operator and attained the rank of Sergeant prior to receiving his commission through ROTC.
