Colonel Scott B. Kindberg

A Distinguished Military Graduate, Colonel Kindberg received his commission in the Transportation Corps from the University of Wisconsin in 1996. He also holds advanced degrees from U.S. Naval War College, and the U.S. Army War College.

During more than 22 years of service, COL Kindberg has been afforded many unique experiences and opportunities with the 1st Cavalry Division, 3rd Army ARCENT (Kuwait & Atlanta, Georgia), 1st Infantry Division (Kitzingen, Germany), 8th Transportation Brigade, 7th Sustainment Brigade (Fort Eustis, Virginia), United States Forces Japan (Tokyo, Japan), the 266th Quartermaster Battalion, and the 23rd Quartermaster Brigade (Fort Lee, Virginia).

His assignments at the tactical level include: Transportation Platoon Leader, Movement Control Officer, (1st CAV) Company Commander, (1ID) Battalion and Brigade S2/S3, Battalion and Brigade Executive Officer (7th SB) and Quartermaster Battalion Commander.

COL Kindberg's combat tours include a deployment to Bosnia-Herzegovina in 1999 as the 1st CAV DISCOM Movement Control Officer, a deployment to Kuwait as the Transportation Operations Officer with 3rd Army in 2001 for Operation Enduring Freedom, a deployment to Iraq as company commander with the 1st Infantry Division in 2004-2005, a deployment to Iraq as the 7th Special Troops Battalion Executive Officer in 2005-2007, and a deployment in support of Operation Freedom Sentinel as the CENTCOM Deployment and Distribution Operations Center in 2018-2019. Other significant assignments include selection as a Joint Logistics Officer with an assignment to the United States Forces of Japan, as the Chief, Transportation Plans and Operations, and the Force Development Directorate Executive Officer with the Combined Arms Support Command and to CENTCOM CCJ4 CDDOC. A distinguished military honor graduate, a graduate of the Transportation Basic Course and Combined Logistics Captain's Career Course, COL Kindberg is a graduate of the Naval Command and Staff College, Joint and Combined Warfighting School, and the Army War College.

His awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal (with one oak leaf cluster), the Defense Meritorious Service Medal, the Meritorious Service Medal (with three oak leaf clusters), the Army Commendation Medal (with two oak leaf clusters), the Joint Service Achievement Medal, the Army Achievement Medal (with four oak leaf clusters), the Combat Action Badge and the Air Assault Badge.
