

LTC Dennis Allen Louck commissioned as an Engineer Officer through the Army ROTC Department at Central Michigan University, Mount Pleasant, Michigan in 2004.

As a Lieutenant, LTC Louck served as an Earth Moving Platoon Leader, Executive Officer, and Battalion Motor Officer in the 46th Engineer Combat Battalion (Heavy) [ECB(H)], Fort Polk, Louisiana. During the battalion's deployment in support of Operation Iraqi Freedom (05-07) LTC Louck deployed initially to Al Taqaddum Airbase, Iraq as a Platoon Leader, and later assumed duties as the Executive Officer in Ar Ramadi, Iraq.



As a Captain, he volunteered for assignment with the Iraqi Military Transition Team (MTT) out of Fort Riley, Kansas. Upon completion of the MTT course, he was deployed to Baghdad, Iraq. He served as the principle advisor to the Engineer Regiment, 11th Iraqi Army Division with additional duties as the 11th Iraqi Division Press Affairs Advisor, Division Enabler Development Officer, and Rusafa Area Command Assistant Operations Advisor. He was then assigned as the Deputy Brigade Engineer for 1st Brigade Combat Team (BCT), 3rd Infantry Division (ID), Fort Stewart, GA. Shortly after arriving, the brigade deployed to Baghdad, Iraq as a Security Force Advice and Assistance Team, where he assumed duties forward as the Deputy Brigade Engineer and Co-Chaired the Counter Improvised Explosive Device and Base Closure Working Groups. Upon redeployment, LTC Louck was reassigned to the 92nd Engineer Battalion, in Fort Stewart, Georgia, serving as the Assistance Operations Officer before taking command of 554th Engineer Company (Vertical), and commanding the 92nd Engineer Battalion Rear-Detachment.

As a Major, he was assigned to XVIII Airborne Corps, Fort Bragg, North Carolina, and immediately deployed in support of Operation Enduring Freedom, serving as the Deputy Afghan National Security Force Engineer Development Officer and Advisor to the Ground Forces Command Engineer Section, as part of the International Joint Command, Kabul, Afghanistan. Upon redeployment, LTC Louck served as the Deputy XVIII Airborne Corps Engineer and Plans Officer. He was then assigned as the Executive Officer, 27th Engineer Battalion (Airborne) before his duties as the 20th Engineer Brigade Operations Officer. He then volunteered to stand up the 2nd Security Force Advise and Assist Brigade (SFAB) serving as a Company Commander and Battalion Operations Officer, for 5th Battalion. During his SFAB deployment, his company advised the 1st Infantry Brigade, 111th Capital Division in Kabul, Afghanistan.

LTC Louck most recently served as the Plans, Operations, and Exercise Chief for the Deputy Chief of Staff Engineers at the United States Army Europe and Africa Headquarters, in Wiesbaden, Germany.

His civilian education consists of a Bachelor of Science in Political Science with a concentration on Public Administration from Central Michigan University. His military education includes; the Engineer Officer Basic Course, U.S. Army Airborne School, Engineer Captains Career Course, Command and General Staff College, and the Military Advisor Training Academy
