Mr. (GS-14) Michael A. Terilli is the Manager and Civilian Deputy Commander, Area Support Group (ASG) – Poland, located in Poznan, Poland. He has served in this capacity since July, 2019.

Mr. Terilli has over 33 years of Federal service, both as an Army Logistics Officer and a Department of the Army Civilian. He has had seven overseas assignments, both on active duty and as a civilian, in Germany, the Netherlands, Korea and Poland.

As the ASG-Poland Manager, Mr. Terilli provides supervision of 44 assigned Department of the Army Civilians as well support to 12 assigned military personnel, providing garrison-type functions and fiscal management oversight of U.S. military, government civilians and contractors in the Poland area of operation.

Mr. Terilli's previous civilian assignments include Resident Student, U.S. Army War College, Carlisle, PA; Division Deputy, U.S. Army Logistics Innovation Agency, New Cumberland, PA; Support Operations Officer, 598th Transportation Brigade, Rotterdam, the Netherlands; Plans Team Lead, G-3, 21st Theater Sustainment Command, Kaiserslautern, Germany.



Besides numerous military awards he received over his career, Mr. Terilli's civilian awards include the Superior Civilian Service Award, three awards of the Commander's Award for Civilian Service and the Achievement Medal for Civilian Service.

Mr. Terilli is a graduate of the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College and the United States Marine Corps Advanced Logistics Officer's Course.
