Ursula Collins became the Deputy General Manager and Logistics Management Officer for the Theater Logistics Support Center-Europe & Africa (TLSC-E/A) in November, 2024. She assumed this role after a distinguished tenure as the Lead Logistics Management Specialist for TLSC-E/A, where she served from December 1998 to 2024.

Her career in government service began in 1982 as a Customer Service Clerk for the 86th Tactical Fighter Wing at Ramstein Air Base. In April 1985, she transitioned to the role of Budget Assistant, serving until April 1986. Following that, she worked as a Program Analyst until November 1990. She then held the position of Lead Program Analyst for the 29th Area Support Group in Kaiserslautern until 1998, where she played a key role in strengthening logistics coordination and support systems. During her role as Lead Logistics Management Specialist, Collins was the primary TLSC-E/A planner for the European Enduring Equipment Set (E3S) while also performing the duties as the CLVII manager for TLSC-E/A.

Throughout her career, Collins has demonstrated exceptional leadership and expertise in logistics management, process improvement, and inter-agency coordination. Her fluency in English (C2) and conversational French (B2) have supported her success in multinational environments.
